

GARBAGE SERVICE

Curbside, garbage and recycling pickup is weekly on Friday. All items are to be placed at the curb by 6 a.m. and are not allowed out any sooner than 24 hours prior to pickup and containers are to be removed from the curb within 24 hours after pickup.

Residents are allowed to place (2) 30 gallon trash bags or two (2) reusable containers, not to exceed a loaded weight of 50 lbs. each. If you have more than allowed, the contractor is not to pick the additional up and is supposed to tag it as such. You can put out any quantity of recyclables each week. **NO LIMIT!!**

The following items can be mixed together:

1. Aluminum cans, container glass (glass clean with caps removed and should not be broken), plastic bottles and containers (#1 & #2 clean bottles/containers except motor oil bottles), and tin cans (clean with labels removed) in one container.
2. Corrugated cardboard (flattened & bundled), mixed papers, and newspapers in one container.
3. Waste oil - there is a drop off site located at the recycle center. PLEASE make sure to take your containers with you.
4. Yard Waste (leaves, grass clippings, yard/garden debris) - The Village has a drop off site located at 104 Degner St. (behind the former Athens Co-Op). When bringing items to this site, please put them in the proper place as noted by the signs!

Residents are allowed to place (2) 30 gallon trash bags or (2) reusable containers, not to exceed a loaded weight of 50 lbs. each. You can put out any quantity of recyclables each week.

Discarded furniture and bulky items can be picked up by Onyx, but you must call them to schedule a pickup (888-271-7176)

WATER

Village of Athens Water utility provides water service to most of the homes in the Village. Please contact the Clerk's office with any questions.

Utility billings are sent monthly. The first and second month of each quarter is estimated on your average usage of the previous six months. The third month of each quarter (March, June, September, and December) an actual read is done. Water bills are sent at the end of the month, with a due date falling on the 20th of

the following month. You can pay your bill at US Bank, the Clerk's office, by mail, or by using the payment drop box located outside the Municipal Building.
